The Complete Law of Creation

&

The Golden Proportional Division

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Parts of this chapter contain more complex information concerning Sacred Science.

For a more in-depth understanding, some of you may need to read it more then once. Please note that it doesn't matter if you don't fully understand the Golden Proportional Division or Fibonacci sequence of numbers and their relation to the function of the Mind. You can still use the rest of the information from this book in order to change your consciousness.

I chose to explain the function of the Mind in this scientific way to demonstrate how a concept can be expressed in words as well as in shapes or numbers.

The Conscious, Subconscious and Superconscious are the three parts or divisions of the Whole Mind. By deliberately bringing awareness into the Conscious, Subconscious and Superconscious parts of the Mind, we activate the Complete Law of Creation in our consciousness. In order for the Complete Law to be present in our consciousness we need to be aware of how the Whole Mind and all of the Universal Laws function.

The Whole Mind consists of the Conscious, Subconscious and Superconscious parts. The Conscious and Subconscious parts are two halves of one unit. If you are seeking to create by using the Whole Mind with Conscious Awareness, it is important first to connect these two halves into one unit. Then you can connect this unit with the Superconscious part of the Mind. When this occurs, *three* parts of Mind become *two* and then they become *one*. Three, which became Two and Two, which became One. This statement describes Divine Proportional Division.

A Divine Creation occurs when the three parts of the Mind—Conscious, Subconscious and Superconscious—are used simultaneously while creating with Conscious Awareness. This process of creating with Conscious Awareness is a function of the Divine Creation.

The Golden Means is an ancient geometric principle of a Perfect Proportional Division. This Golden Perfect Proportional Division is the only three-way division that is possible in two terms. The smaller term is to the larger term as the larger term is to the smaller plus the larger.

This principle illustrates in geometric "shapes" the Divine Proportional Division. The Conscious is to the Subconscious as the Superconscious is to the Conscious plus the Subconscious parts of Mind. Three, which became Two and Two, which became One. Or, the smaller term is to the larger term as the larger term is to the smaller plus the larger.

Since the Divine Proportional Division describes the function of Divine Creation, this principle of Golden Proportional Division illustrates in geometric "shapes" the Complete Law of Creation. The Universal Truth, which would describe in "words" this Complete Law, is **I and the Father are One** = *Three*, which became *Two* and *Two*, which became *One*. It also works in reverse: *One*, when divided in *Two* becomes *Three*. See the picture below. When line c is divided into two sections of (a) and (b) using the Golden Proportional Division, the proportion between (a) and (b) is the same as between (c) and (a).

Mathematically, the Golden or Perfect Proportional Division calculated as an irrational number "Phi" is: 1.61803339... or 0. 61803339... In the irrational number, fractionating never ends and the pattern of the fractionated numbers never repeats.

For example, if (c) is 1.618033339 of an inch, (a) would be one inch and (b) would be 0.618033330...of an inch. Thus, (c) and (a) are in the same proportion as (a) and

(b).

An algebraic equation of the Golden Perfect Proportional Division is:

a:b::c:a

The geometrical equation for the Golden Perfect Proportional Division

is:

#1 or (a) = represent the side of the square.

This picture of the Golden Proportional Division constructed in geometrical "shapes" is an example of the Universal Truth: I and the Father are One, which defines the Complete Law of Creation. Since, as we now know, Beauty is illustrated Truth in shapes, forms, sounds, colors, smells and/or tastes, this geometric "shape" illustrates Beauty as a function of Divine Creation in its essence.

Reasoning is a function of the Conscious; Intuition is a function of the Subconscious; and Divine Guidance is a function of the Superconscious part of the Mind.

To use the Whole Mind with Conscious Awareness while simultaneously using the Conscious, Subconscious and Superconscious parts of the Mind, we need to apply Reasoning, Intuition and Divine Guidance simultaneously, with awareness.

This indicates that we Reason with Intuition and Divine Guidance rather than blindly accepting and applying Intuitive and Divine messages. With Reasoning we seek to understand why and how we received these messages. We also want to know what will occur when we apply these messages to our life and the lives of others.

Everyone's consciousness is a part of the Whole Mind. Without the life-giving source

of energy which comes to our consciousness through the Whole Mind, we would not exist. This life-giving source is God's love and attention. Attention is available to us for application in the Conscious part of the Mind through use of our Free Will.

Many use their mind without Conscious Awareness, causing the source of God's attention to become segmented or divided so that each of our senses is experienced separately rather than as a whole. Divided attention disconnects our consciousness from the Divine flow of energy. However, God never ceases to give us His love and attention and it is only because of our divided attention that we are not aware of this Divine Presence.

With Will Power we can successfully maintain our Undivided Attention by first connecting our Conscious part of the Mind with the Subconscious. Then we can connect both of these parts with the Superconscious.

Most people habitually function in each part of the Mind separately. In the waking hours they function only in the Conscious part. During sleeping hours, their attention automatically switches to the Subconscious and sometimes to the Superconscious part. Only occasionally do they access the Subconscious and/or the Superconscious during their waking hours.

This might be the habitual way of using our Intuition and Divine Guidance. Examples and explanation of habitual reception of messages from the Subconscious and/or Superconscious parts of the Mind during waking hours is described in Chapter Two when we discussed Intuition.

CONSCIOUS Part of the Mind

The Conscious part of the Mind is linked to the Physical body. Both leave together when their time is up (or, when the life force leaves the Physical body). The Subconscious and Superconscious, however, continue to exist. The *activity* of the Conscious part of the Mind is to have experiences in the Physical world during our lifetime. All experiences

from one lifetime are stored in our brain memory.

The *purpose* of the Conscious part of the Mind is to learn from those experiences. We use our Reasoning to do this by creating Physical desires and then learning from the manifested experiences. Reasoning is a function of the Conscious part of the Mind. It is another name for our creative ability.

The *goal* of the Conscious part of the Mind is to formulate desires.

SUBCONSCIOUS Part of the Mind

Understandings developed during the learning process are the nourishment of the Soul. Our Soul resides in the Subconscious part of the Mind. Once an understanding is developed in the Conscious part of the Mind, it is automatically stored in the Subconscious part. The *purpose* of the Subconscious is to hold or store these understandings.

The activity of the Subconscious is Intuition. Intuition is the direct grasp of Truth.

The *goal* and duty of the Subconscious are to provide the opportunity for the Conscious part of the Mind to fulfill its desires.

When we use our ego motivation and formulate a desire in the Conscious part of the Mind, the thought image of that desire is automatically placed in our Subconscious. Those desires might be our conscious as well as our unconscious thoughts.

Once placed in the Subconscious part of the Mind, the thought image of the desire activates the Universal Laws of Creation. The Universal Laws connect us to opportunities and situations as a means for manifesting our unconscious thoughts and/or conscious desires. In order to create our desires we need to *act* upon those opportunities when they become visible in our Physical existence.

The *purpose* of both the Conscious and Subconscious parts of the Mind is to learn, and thus it is the act of learning that consciously connects those two parts of the Mind.

We can learn during and/or after the creative process. However, we can only learn about how we create when we know the Cause and Effect of our creations. Therefore, it is important to be aware of our thoughts.

As discussed previously, in order to be aware of our thoughts, we need to still our mind and listen to our unconscious thoughts; or, we can create our thoughts by consciously setting goals and/or imagining our desires.

Once we set a goal or imagine a desire, we become aware of the causal thought. With this awareness we can observe the manifestation of that thought in our Physical life.

Therefore, in order to be able to learn from the creative process, we need to manifest our goals and/or desires. Through observation and comparison of the causal thought with its manifestation, we can learn whether or not our thought harmonizes with the Universal Laws.

Having a *goal*, *purpose* and *activity* in our consciousness while creating, insures the learning process. As we now know, an *activity* brings thought into the Physical world. The *purpose* is the learning process and the *goal* is our "conscious causal" thought.

We would merely be daydreamers if we visualized our desires or consciously set goals without responding to or acting on our opportunities. Without taking action, Physical manifestation of our desires cannot happen. Also, we would have no outcomes to use for observation and learning opportunities. Without taking action, the entire goal-oriented thought process would be purposeless.

Purposeless goals and activities would merely produce Physical creations without giving the Soul an opportunity to be fulfilled because there would be no understandings to give to the Subconscious.

Acting without goals is like blindly going through the motions of living while only habitually creating life situations. We would be creating and manifesting only our unconscious thoughts. Creating without Conscious Awareness of the causal thought also provides no purpose or learning.

In order to have a *goal*, *purpose* and *activity* in our consciousness while creating, our attention needs to be in the present. In order to have our attention in the present, we need to have a stilled mind. The stilled mind with attention in the present is conducive to Reasoning, Intuition and Divine Guidance. Creating consciously with a Goal, Purpose and Activity while Reasoning with Intuition and Divine Guidance is Divine Creation. We use the Whole Mind while creating with Conscious Awareness.

We have learned that Reasoning consists of memory, attention and imagination. Memory relates to the past, attention to the present, and imagination to the future. With our attention in the present we can observe the present situation and compare it to a similar situation in the past. This connects the past with the present. With the past and the present connected, we can imagine a better situation in the future.

Once the imagined future manifests in our Physical lives, it automatically becomes the present, while the previous present automatically becomes the past. The previous past did not disappear. Remember, it was connected to the present while imagining the future. Please note that in this process nothing is ever lost because when the future becomes the present, all past continues to exist in the present. The Past is to the Present in the same way the Future is to the Past plus the Present.

This illustrates how the principle of Golden or Divine Proportional Division is used in creating while using Reasoning. Golden or Perfect Proportional Division is the only three-way proportional division that is possible in two terms. The Smaller term is to the Larger term in the same way the Larger term is to the Smaller plus the Larger.

When the Proportional Principle of Golden Means is continuously applied through Reasoning, the present will keep expanding while nothing is lost. Therefore, the Principle of Golden Proportional Division applied consciously through Reasoning causes Progression.

Now we can see that the Golden Proportional Division describes the Reasoning process as well as Divine Creation. When Reasoning is used only for causing Progression in our Physical life, we would be creating on a small scale. However, when Reasoning is used to activate the Whole Mind while causing the Spiritual Progression, this would be Divine Creation, or a higher level of creating.

With a goal, purpose and activity we will always have learning that can be added to our consciousness. Thus, we will always have Spiritual Progression.

If we use the Whole Mind while creating, we are always aware of Who we are, Where we came from and Where we are going. Our Soul resides in the Subconscious part of the Mind. That is Who we are. It is the present. Memory experiences and learning that occurred while using the Conscious part of the Mind represent Where we came from. This is the past. To fulfill God's Plan, which is stored in the Superconscious, is Where we are going. This is our future and our destiny.

SUPERCONSCIOUS Part of the Mind

As we now know, the Plan in the Superconscious is about us as individuals of Humanity. The *goal* is to fulfill the Plan. The *activity* is the life-giving source, and the *purpose* is to hold the Plan. The Plan contains information about how to become creators with Conscious Awareness of Who we are, Where we came from and Where we are going. The simplest and most profound way of using the Golden or Divine Proportional Division while creating our new consciousness is **always to be proud of and grateful for Where we came from and Who we Became.**

We do this by keeping our attention in the present, at the same time being aware and proud of our past. It is important to acknowledge our past because it is those experiences and their learning that made us Who we are today. "Gratitude consciousness" connects the present with the past.

When we integrate our past and present simultaneously with Conscious Awareness, we create our future according to the Divine or Golden Proportional Division. The Past is to the Present in the same way as the Future is to the Past and the Present. When using

the Golden or Divine Proportional Division in this manner, we are fully functioning and therefore perfect in every stage of our Spiritual Progression.

I and the Father are One is the Universal Truth describing the Complete Law of Creation. Once we are connected with the Superconscious, We are all One. Therefore "One" represents the Superconscious part of the Mind. "I" represents our Soul in the Subconscious part. Past experiences and learning while using the Conscious part of the Mind represent the "Father." By uniting the Conscious, Subconscious and Superconscious parts of the Mind while using the Golden or Divine Proportional Division, we apply the Universal Truth: I and the Father are One. This is the Universal Truth, which describes the Complete Law of Creation and when applied, activates this Law within our consciousness.

The Principle of Golden or Divine Proportional Division as well as all Principles are "changeless"; however, Progression occurs through Continuous application of the Principle of Golden or Divine Proportional Division, while creating. The Golden Proportion is the only Division which applies the Principle and Progression at the same time.

The picture of this Progression can be seen in the Fibonacci Sequence of Numbers 1, 2, 3, 5, 8, 13, 21, 34... In the Fibonacci Sequence of Numbers, each two previous numbers added, form the next "progressive" number: 1+2=3, 2+3=5, 3+5=8, 5+8=13, 8+13=21, 13+21=34 and so on. *One* is to *Two* in the same way as *Two* is to *Three* (1+2). *Two* is to *Three* in the same way as *Three* is to *Five* (2+3), and so on.

This sequence of numbers is based on the Principle of Golden Proportional Division:

The smaller term is to the larger term in the same way as the larger is to the smaller plus the larger = a:b::a:c (c=a+b). The smaller term or (b) is to the larger term or (a) as the larger term (a) is to the smaller plus larger term (a+b), which is (c). This shows the application of the Principle of Golden Proportional Division in the Fibonacci

Progressive Sequence of Numbers. In other words, the Principle of Golden Division when applied progressively = Fibonacci Progressive Sequence of Numbers.

The Principles of Creation never change, yet the Principles of Creation applied with Reasoning while holding the goal, purpose and activity in Mind, produce Spiritual Progression.

The Universal Laws are the way God thinks or creates. Universal Truth describes the Universal Law in words. Beauty describes the Universal Laws in shapes, forms, smells, tastes, colors and/or sounds.

We can observe the manifestation of God's thoughts in the Beauty of Nature, where we will also find the Principle of Golden Means. God loves us all unconditionally. Therefore, the information which Truth or Beauty provides always includes concern for the Goodness of All. That's why True Beauty has a creative or healing power.

For example, a sunflower is a Beautiful flower whose seeds contain many nutrients which our body needs. A couple of Tablespoons of sunflower seeds include enough protein for an entire day.

The structure of the seed formation in the center of the flower is based on the Fibonacci sequence of numbers. Two directions of half-circle lines of seeds cross each other. One direction goes to the right and the other to the left. Both sets of half-circles always correspond to the numbers in the Fibonacci sequence.

For example, when one set contains 21 of the half-circles going to the right, the other set going to the left would contain 34 half-circles. Both the numbers 21 and 34 are included in the Fibonacci sequence of numbers.

Another example of the Golden Proportion manifested in forms of Nature can be found in a cabbage, also a highly nutritious plant. Cabbage contains most of the vitamins and minerals our body needs. Because of its high vitamin and mineral content, we could survive eating only cabbage if we had to.

The structure of the leaves in the cabbage plant is also based on the principle of Golden

Proportional Division. Each progressive leaf in a cabbage plant grows at an angle of 222.5 degrees. The 222.5 degrees is an angle in the Golden Proportion division of a circle. This angle provides the maximum light for the next leaf to grow.

The geometric shape of a pentagon is structured proportionally, based on the principle of Golden Means. One side of a pentagon is in Golden Proportion to the diagonal line of the pentagon.

The pentagon has five equal sides. All plants whose form-structures are based on the pentagon shape or the number five, are edible. For example, a maple leaf has five points. When connecting the five points with a line, the outlined shape would resemble a pentagon. Maple tree seeds and their sap are edible. Another example of an edible plant with five petals forming a pentagon shape is the orchid.

God gave Humans Free Will and thus, dominion over the lower root races of gases, minerals, plants and animals. However, our disharmonious thoughts and selfish Physical, Emotional and Mental interactions created the disharmony that we currently witness in Nature.

Nature's cycles are also interrupted because of our disharmonious thoughts and actions. Disorders in Nature are distorted manifestations of God thoughts caused by Human interference. We Humans need to take responsibility for the disharmonious manifestations of shapes, forms and cycles of Nature. Therefore, it is important to act and think responsibly with conscious concern for the Goodness of All. Our harmonious thoughts and actions can restore Nature once again to its own state of Divine Harmonious Order.

Ancient human-made structures such as the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx are also constructed according to the principle of Golden Means. Within the measurements of these ancient structures is information about the circumference of the Earth, the distance between the Earth and the Moon and many more configurations that have not yet been scientifically decoded. Did we Humans build those structures? If so, would it mean that

we were more evolved 50,000 years ago?

Since evolution only goes forward, Humans could not be more evolved 50,000 years ago. However, Human consciousness was connected with Divine Guidance while building these structures. Thus, 50,000 years ago we were creating with Divine Guidance.

Reasoning is the creative power in the Conscious part of the Mind. Reasoning consists of memory, attention and imagination. In order to create or Reason responsibly with concern for the Goodness of All, we need to have a sufficient sum of memory experiences. Children have excellent Reasoning capabilities. However, because they haven't lived long enough to have many experiences stored in their brain, their ability to make productive choices is limited. Therefore, in order for a child to be safe, for example, they need to be taught certain safety rules. Adults teach these rules to their young children without giving them too many explanations, since children are not yet able to understand the purpose for these rules.

For example, they need to be told *not* to play with matches. If you would Reason with a small child by trying to explain why playing with matches is dangerous, most likely the child would try to negotiate with you. They would try to convince you that they will be very careful while playing with the matches and they will *not* set the house on fire. Continuing this type of conversation would more than likely be a waste of time.

Fifty thousand years ago, Human consciousness had a limited Reasoning memory bank. Therefore, in order for us to be productive when we created, we needed to follow Divine directions. We built the Pyramids, Sphinx and other ancient monuments with Divine Guidance, without trying to understand their purpose. This purpose was part of a much larger scale of creation that includes concern for the Whole Universe.

For example, structures similar to the Pyramids of Giza and the Sphinx in Egypt were found on Mars. To date, our scientists still don't understand why and how they were built. (For more information, read *The Monuments on Mars*, by Richard C. Hoagland.)

The Bible and other Holy Books contain coded information about the evolution of

Human consciousness. These books also contain coded instruction about how to grow in consciousness in order to become in the likeness of God.

In *Genesis*, Chapter 1, is a story about Adam and Eve. In the Garden of Eden, God instructs Adam and Eve to eat fruit from all trees, including the Tree of Life, and *not* from the Tree of Knowledge.

The Tree of Life represents the connection with Divine Guidance. The Tree of Knowledge represents Reasoning. This means that God wanted us to obey Divine instruction without trying to understand the Reason behind what was being Divinely created.

At that time when Human consciousness was in its infancy, it would have been incapable of comprehending the larger scheme of Creation. Through observation, while obediently participating in the act of creation we were supposed to learn why and how to create consciously with concern for the Goodness of All. Thus, we would be able to gradually earn the right to become responsible creators with Conscious Awareness of why and how to create in the likeness of God.

As explained in previous chapters, we now know that Divine Guidance comes from Divine Intelligence, or God. Guidance is channeled from Divine Intelligence through the Superconscious and the Subconscious to the Conscious part of the Mind as Divine and/or Intuitive messages. Since we were instructed to follow Divine Guidance 50,000 years ago while creating, this means that Humans were supposed to evolve by using our Intuition first, before learning how to Reason.

However, some of us didn't obey. We tried to understand the purpose behind the large scale of Creation while we were participating in creating it. In other words, we ate from the Tree of Knowledge.

We became Emotionally overwhelmed. This Emotional misunderstanding caused a separation of our consciousness from Intuitive and Divine Guidance. The ones who disobeyed are called Humans. As a result of the separation, Human consciousness

became trapped in Physical thinking.

The separation from Divine Guidance caused fear of survival and this fear produced a selfish motivation for creating. Selfish motivation leads to powerlessness or greed consciousness. Powerless thinking leads to poverty and greed results in hoarding. When we hoard we create without purpose.

Both of these unproductive thought processes are selfish. By thinking they are powerless, poor people are selfish because they refuse to use their God given creative power. Poor people do not give of themselves to the Whole. Greedy people are selfish because they use their creative abilities only for themselves. Poor or greedy people are self-consumed.

Unfortunately, the reason for most Humans to live and create is motivated by fear. We can see reflections of this selfish fear motivation in all of our existing civilizations. People live in extreme conditions with the rich separated from the poor.

Continuation of the early history of our Mental evolution is described in the Bible story, *Genesis*, Chapter 2. Adam and Eve did not obey Divine instruction and ate from the Tree of Knowledge. Afterward, realizing they were naked they became ashamed and tried to cover themselves with fig leaves. Because of their disobedience, Adam and Eve were chased out of the Garden of Eden.

An attempt to understand what was beyond our comprehension at that time caused us to be aware of our lack of knowledge about Creation. We became ashamed of what we didn't know. Most people still feel ashamed when caught not knowing something. Therefore, "the shame" in this Bible story represents recognition of all that we don't understand.

"The Garden of Eden" represents safe conditions of living and creating with Divine Guidance. Being chased from the Garden of Eden illustrates losing the security of Divine Guidance. Losing our security leads to fear of surviving on our own.

This story is similar to that of a small child who would try to understand their parents'

duties. Children have natural tendencies to feel responsible. However, they lack ability to understand their parents' full responsibilities. This information would overwhelm them and cause them to have an Emotional breakdown.

After a traumatic experience of that nature, the child would feel helpless and experience fear of survival. They may be afraid to leave their room, needing time to heal emotionally in order to be able to continue to associate with others once again and live a normal healthy life.

We can compare this situation to that of the Humans in the Biblical story who needed time to recover from their mistake. Therefore, the Plan for evolution of Human consciousness was changed. By disobeying Divine instructions, we lost our ability to be consciously Intuitive. Thus, we retreated to Physical thinking. In order to learn we gave priority to the function of Reasoning instead of Intuition, thus altering the original Plan for Human evolution. Instead of learning through observation of the Divine Creation, we learn through our mistakes.

The Law of Karma became our Insurance for further Evolution of our Consciousness.

Karma is the adjusted Universal Law of Cause and Effect. Cause is the Thought and Effect is its Physical Manifestation. This is the Universal Truth explaining the Universal Law of Cause and Effect. Thought is the Cause, yet Awareness of the Intention behind the Thought influences the Physical Manifestation of the Thought. This is the Truth explaining the Law of Karma. The *Intention* of our thoughts rather than the *exact thought* manifests. Karma was created to make us aware of our Intentions.

If our Intention for creating is selfish, the outcome of our thoughts is unpleasant. This is because each selfish thought causes more separation from Divine Guidance. Separation causes more fear. Living in fear is unpleasant.

On the contrary, when our Intention includes concern for the Goodness of All, we experience a sense of security and happiness. This occurs whenever our consciousness connects with the Whole Creation.

We can imagine the Whole Creation as a large tree. The leaves of the tree would represent our individual consciousness. Losing our connection with Divine Guidance is similar to individual leaves of the tree losing awareness that they all belong to one tree.

Therefore, when one individual leaf would think that its existence was separate, in order to survive, the leaf would start to function out of fear. Fear produces selfishness and selfishness leads to a loss of objectivity. When objectivity is lost, even if the leaf would manage to collect some water, it would choose to use all the collected water to spray only itself. "I have to look out for myself because after all, who knows what will happen tomorrow?" the leaf would selfishly think.

Selfish Intention would produce a selfish outcome. The next day, less water would be sent to the leaf from the life-giving source of the large tree. This would cause the leaf to experience more anxiety about how to survive. The leaf would have more reasons to think and act selfishly. It would continue to gather water just for itself. Selfish Intentions would produce more problems in further receiving life-sustaining water from the source of the large tree. If the leaf continued in the same selfish manner, it would eventually dry out and fall off the tree.

Karma creates an unpleasant experience whenever a selfish Intention is our motivation. The Law of Karma is here for us as insurance for our further growth. Our destiny is to grow in God-likeness and God always thinks for the Goodness of All.

The Law of Karma insures that we will eventually recognize that each selfish thought produces fear, pain and more insecurity. **Karma is just**; therefore, through Karma we are also able to recognize that thoughts that include concern for others produce security and happiness. In order to be happy we must start to expand our consciousness and have concern for the Goodness of All.

The Goodness for All consciousness expands the Mind. With an expanded Mind we can see more objectively. Therefore, with concern for the Goodness for All, the leaf would be able to recognize that there is a more productive choice then to collect the water just for itself.

With concern for the Goodness of All, the leaf would be able to see that it is part of a cluster of other leaves and all of them belong to one large tree. By recognizing the importance of working together with the other leaves, the leaf would become responsible. It would be able to discover that watering the roots of the tree instead of selfishly hoarding the water for its own purposes is a much more productive choice. By watering the roots the whole tree can grow, and the leaves would always receive more water from the source. Now there would be no reason to fear survival.

After thousands of years of creating and learning from mistakes, Human Reasoning ability has evolved to the point where a large number of experiences are stored in our brains and also in our historical archives. When we Reason, we are able to draw upon these experiences and thus avoid repeating the same mistakes. It is said that history repeats itself. This only occurs when we do not learn from previous experiences.

Now Humans are capable of becoming responsible creators. It's okay to make a wrong decision if the Intention is selfless. However, it is not responsible to repeat the same wrong decision. Responsibility is the use of Reasoning for the purpose of learning and growing. In order to learn and grow we need to keep expanding our consciousness. By including concern for others in our thinking, we expand our consciousness.

Each of us has a different capacity for being responsible, based on the extent and degree of our expansiveness. We also have differing types and degrees of understanding and abilities for exercising objectivity.

Some have the ability to be concerned for their entire family. Their responsibility is to serve their family in every possible manner. Another person is able to include the entire nation in their consciousness. Their responsibility is to serve the whole nation. Whenever you give your best unconditionally you are adding to the Whole and your consciousness expands. Therefore, you also become happier and more secure. It is also our

responsibility to be constantly improving upon our thoughts and actions. While creating, it could happen that you make a decision with a selfless Intention, yet that choice might not produce the desired result. Your choice may have been a mistake.

If you didn't make that choice, you wouldn't know it was a wrong one. Therefore, in order to be a responsible creator, you need to learn from your mistakes and move on. Learning consists of taking responsibility even for choices that may be unproductive, and always progressing toward your goal with concern for the Goodness of All.

When your Intention is selfless and you have learned from your mistakes, the Universal Laws will lead you toward opportunities for which you will be able to make more productive choices.

If your Intentions were selfish, the consequences will lead to disappointments and insecurities in areas of your life that are important to you. However, we need to always remember that selfless Intentions connect us with the Whole and therefore they always bring more security.

Some people may think that money will bring them security. This can only occur if the Intention is selfless. For example, Howard Hughes, the richest man in the world, died from fear of germs. Even his enormous wealth could not protect him from his own fears.
